PROJECT AIM

SECUREFOOD SUPPORTS THE TRANSITION TOWARD MORE RESILIENT AND SUSTAINABLE FOOD SYSTEMS BY COMBINING GOVERNANCE INNOVATION WITH PRACTICAL TOOLS FOR RESILIENCE ASSESSMENT AND MANAGEMENT.



THE CHALLENGE

STRENGTHENING THE RESILIENCE AND SUSTAINABILITY OF FOOD SYSTEMS REQUIRES INTEGRATED, SYSTEM-LEVEL APPROACHES. CURRENT SYSTEMS FACE CHALLENGES RELATED TO COORDINATION, GOVERNANCE, ENVIRONMENTAL PRESSURES, AND THE NEED FOR MORE EFFECTIVE RESILIENCE PLANNING.



APPROACH

SECUREFOOD DEVELOPS TWO COMPLEMENTARY FRAMEWORKS:

- + A RESILIENCE GOVERNANCE FRAMEWORK TO SUPPORT COLLABORATION AND COORDINATION
- + A FOOD SYSTEMS RESILIENCE MANAGEMENT (FSRM) FRAMEWORK TO GUIDE RESILIENCE ASSESSMENT AND ACTION

THESE FRAMEWORKS ALIGN WITH EUROPEAN PRIORITIES, INCLUDING THE FARM TO FORK STRATEGY AND FOOD 2030.

RESILIENCE GOVERNANCE FRAMEWORK

1 Multi-actor collaboration across the food system

2 Improved trust and coordination

3 Clear roles and responsibilities

4 Uptake of project results beyond the project lifecycle

FSRM FRAMEWORK

THE FSRM FRAMEWORK SUPPORTS:

- + RESILIENCE ASSESSMENT AND PREPAREDNESS
- + ADAPTIVE CAPACITY BUILDING
- + DECISION-MAKING AT NATIONAL AND STAKEHOLDER LEVELS

IT INTEGRATES KEY CONSIDERATIONS SUCH AS:

- + BIODIVERSITY
- + ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES
- + RISK MANAGEMENT



IMPACT

SECUREFOOD STRENGTHENS MORE RESILIENT AND SUSTAINABLE FOOD SYSTEMS BY IMPROVING GOVERNANCE AND OPERATIONAL CAPACITY ACROSS THE FOOD ECOSYSTEM. IT ENHANCES COORDINATION AND COLLABORATION AMONG STAKEHOLDERS, SUPPORTING MORE INCLUSIVE AND EFFECTIVE DECISION-MAKING PROCESSES.



THE PROJECT ALSO PROVIDES STRUCTURED TOOLS FOR ASSESSING AND MANAGING RESILIENCE, HELPING STAKEHOLDERS ANTICIPATE RISKS, IMPROVE PREPAREDNESS, AND ADAPT TO DISRUPTIONS. BY INTEGRATING ENVIRONMENTAL AND SUSTAINABILITY PRIORITIES SUCH AS BIODIVERSITY AND RESOURCE MANAGEMENT, SECUREFOOD ALIGNS RESILIENCE EFFORTS WITH LONG-TERM SUSTAINABILITY AND EUROPEAN POLICY GOALS.
